

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-12**

**GLOUCESTER COUNTY INSURANCE COMMISSION  
RESOLUTION OF AUTHORITY FOR SETTLEMENT WITH  
PETITIONER, FERNANDO MIRANDA**

**WHEREAS**, Fernando Miranda, a park ranger, sustained a work related injury involving a slip and fall while walking down steps on or about May 4, 2010, resulting in a non-displaced transverse linear fracture of the medial malleolus, however, subsequent to a surgery on or about May 6, 2010, the final injury sustained was right medial malleolus fracture of the ankle (hereinafter "incident" or "the incident"), and;

**WHEREAS**, the incident subsequently resulted in the filing of a workers' compensation claim styled as Fernando Miranda v. Gloucester County in the Workers' Compensation Court, Claim Petition No. 2010-21456 (hereafter "action" or "the action"), and;

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned claim and action so filed have now been resolved, and;

**WHEREAS**, a "SETTLEMENT" (hereinafter "Settlement") has been negotiated and agreed upon between the Petitioner, Fernando Miranda (hereinafter "Petitioner" and/or "the Petitioner") and the County of Gloucester, \$9,752.00 plus Commissioner's share of fees and costs of \$1,460.00 totaling **\$11,212.00**, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Settlement is not intended, nor should it be intended to be an admission of any liability wrongdoing, or impropriety by the parties, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Settlement has been evaluated by defense counsel for the Gloucester County Insurance Commission, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Gloucester County Insurance Commission believes that it is in its' best interests to enter into the Settlement with Petitioner so as to ensure that all matters set forth in and involving the claim and action are forever resolved,

Now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Gloucester County Insurance Commission that disposition of the claim filed by the above referenced individual is authorized as follows:
